**SYNOPSIS**

Arnold Lobel's well-loved characters hop from the page to the stage in Robert and Willie Reale's musical A Year With Frog And Toad. Conceived by Mr. Lobel's daughter, Adrienne Lobel, A Year With Frog And Toad remains true to the spirit of the original stories as it follows two great friends, the cheerful and popular Frog and the rather grumpy Toad through four fun-filled seasons. Waking from hibernation in the spring, they proceed to plant gardens, swim, rake leaves and go sledding, learning life lessons along the way, including a most important one about friendship and rejoicing in the attributes that make each of us different and special.

**FIRST AUDITION**

All students in grades 2 – 8 are able to audition. Students will be scheduled in groups based on their grade level (see below). If a student is not available during their grade level time, we can arrange for them to be included in another group.

**CALLBACK**

Sometimes we need to have a second audition. This is called a callback. Not every student who auditions will be called back. Do not assume that if you didn't get called back, you did not get cast. The directors might know where they want to put you already. Likewise, those who do get called back are not guaranteed to be cast. The callback audition will be on Thursday, September 16.

**AUDITION REQUIREMENTS**

Completely fill out the audition form. Make sure to list all your conflicts on the back of the form. We can work around them if we know in advance.

- Students will learn and sing a song from the show in groups and alone
- Students will learn and perform a dance routine in groups
- Students will read selections from the script

**PARTICIPATION FEE**

A \$30 fee will be added to your student's account in order to participate in the play. This eliminates the need to collect money at different times for rehearsal CDs, lunch/snacks during dress rehearsals, the cast party, stage make-up and other expenses.
